## University Students' Acoustics Poster Competition Grant

April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2008

### Summary

Grants are available for up to \$300 each for the purchase of equipment needed to conduct measurements for student participation in the acoustics poster competition at the joint annual conference of the National Society of Black Physicists (NSBP) and the National Society of Hispanic Physicists (NSHP). Rules and eligibility requirements are listed below.

### 1. Competition

- Research should be on a topic in any subfield of acoustics.
- Each poster must be self-explanatory.
- Students are required to submit a 3-5 page summary paper.
- Students will also be required to deliver a talk on the research.
- Judging will be based on scientific merit of research, written, visual, and oral presentation quality, and demonstrated subject knowledge.
- Awards will be \$600, \$400, and \$200 for the first, second, and third place students, respectively.
- Winners will be invited to attend and present their work at the following meeting of the Acoustical Society of America.

### 2. Reimbursement

- A limited number of grants will be awarded for up to \$300 each.
- The equipment will become the property of the university department in which the student is enrolled.
- Applications will be evaluated based on demonstrated need.
- Grant applications should be submitted by the faculty professor who is supervising the student's project.
- Grant application should be submitted with the title and abstract of the proposed research four (4) months before the date of the competition or as otherwise indicated in the announcement.

  - Name of person or institution to whom the grant funds should be paid
  - Applicants who are awarded grants will be required to submit receipts for the purchase of equipment.
- Funds from this grant can only be used as outlined in the application.
