ROSSING PRIZE IN ACOUSTICS EDUCATION

Nomination deadline: 15 March 2011

The Acoustical Society of America (ASA) announces the availability of a prize to honor an individual who has made significant contributions toward furthering acoustics education, through distinguished teaching, creation of educational materials, textbook writing, and other activities.

Eligibility: An individual must be nominated by a colleague or a present or former student. The nominee need not be a member of the Acoustical Society of America.

Award: The 2011 award consists of a medal, a certificate, a \$4,000 stipend, and reimbursement of travel expenses up to \$1,000 to attend the San Diego ASA meeting, where the medal and certificate will be presented.

Evaluation and Selection Process: Nominations will be reviewed and evaluated by a subcommittee of the ASA Committee on Education in Acoustics.

Nomination Procedure: Nominations require completion of a one-page form, a current curriculum vitae, a nominating letter, and two (or more) seconding letters. At least one letter must be from a Fellow of the Society. The CV should include, in addition to a list of publications, a summary of other educational relevant materials, such as books and videos, to be considered by the subcommittee.

All materials should be sent to the address indicated below, with postmark no later than 15 March 2011. The individual who is selected will be notified before 1 June 2011.

Expectations of Prize Winner: The award will be presented at the Plenary Session at the Fall 2011 ASA meeting in San Diego, CA. At this meeting the recipient will be expected to deliver the "Prize Lecture in Acoustics Education" within a session sponsored by the Committee on Education in Acoustics
